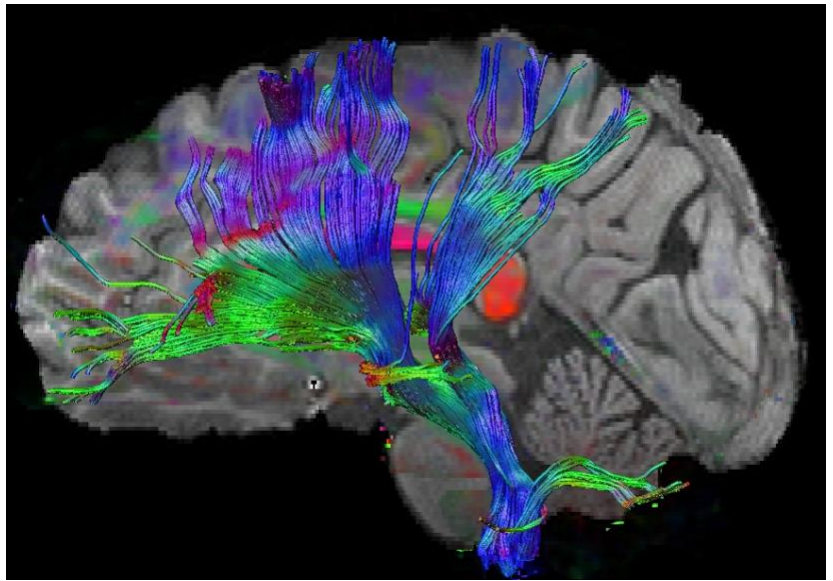


Do you think

Brain Development Imaging Lab

The Brain Development Imaging Laboratory is beginning a new study to examine aging in people with autism spectrum disorders (ASD). We are looking for adults with ASD or suspected ASD (40-75 years old) to participate in the study. This 5-year project will fill a large gap in our current knowledge of ASD. Although many children and adolescents show improvements with age, virtually nothing is known about changes in brain and behavior after age 40 years. Help us find the answers!
